

## **Programming Internship (1 Total)**

Durham Performing Arts Center in Downtown Durham seeks a Programming Intern to assist the Director of Programming-Concerts and Comedy as an integral part of the booking department. Please note this will be a semester long internship running August through December with potential for an extension to run the entire season through May. Interns will get a hands-on look into what goes into making DPAC consistently ranked among the top ten most attended and highest grossing theaters in the US. Projects may include artist/event research and assisting in maintaining the event database. Ideal candidates would have excellent internet researching abilities, excellent communication skills, and proficiency in Excel, math, statistics/analytics, negotiation and business theory/strategy. Should be a detail-oriented and able to work independently, with an enthusiasm and desire to pursue a career in the entertainment industry.

## Requirements:

- \*Current enrollment at a college/university. (Undergraduate junior or senior preferred.)
- \*Candidates must be based in the Triangle and have reliable transportation to work out of the DPAC offices. Parking is provided.
- \*Letter from school stating that intern will receive college credit for the internship.
- \*Proficiency to use Microsoft Office programs, including Microsoft Word and Excel.
- \*Must have a computer that you can bring with you to work.
- \*Availability to work at least 10-15 hours per week at DPAC with occasional availability for weekend and special events.
- \*Business/Marketing, Communication, or Parks/Recreation major preferred but not required.
- \*Please note there will be the potential for fall interns to have their internship renewed for the full 2014/2015 season (running through May 2015) pending college credit requirements and a performance evaluation to take place in December.
